

Male Knitting Adventures

Boots and Clothing

The occasion to show off your beautiful handknits!

- Light Hiking Boots – The boots should be comfortable to walk in and give sufficient support.
- Long sleeve shirt and leggings (thermal underwear) – Wool or synthetic (1st layer)
- Warm wool (or fleece) sweater (2nd layer): 2 sweaters or cardigans.
- Rain Jacket or an Anorak with hood – Preferably waterproof and breathable material (Gore-Tex or equivalents).
- Rain trousers (optional) – Waterproof and breathable material.
- Liner Gloves or Mittens – Wool (or synthetic: polypropylene / polyester)
- Socks – Wool (or synthetic). Two or three pairs.
- Hat – Wool (or synthetic).
- Sun hat
- A scarf, Cowl or Shawl - Wool (or synthetic).
- Inner slippers (for inside the guesthouse)
- Downtown party clothing

Other gear

- Water container
- A small backpack for day excursions.
- Swimsuit and towel
- Sunglasses – Big enough to cover the eyes and with sufficient UV-protection.
- Suncream
- Ear plugs

Optional gear

- Walking poles.
- Binocular
- Camera, spare batteries

Knitting equipment

Please make sure to bring the following knitting equipment for the workshops - the yarn is supplied to knit swatches and a doll size sweater.

- 1 circular needle 4,5 mm /US 7 with a thin flexible 60-80 cm cable (using Magic loop but do bring double pointed needles as well if you don't know or are not comfortable with Magic loop) to knit the doll sweater
- 1 circular needle of same size or smaller size
- darning needle
- tapestry needle
- hook 3 mm/ US D3
- sewing needle and thread
- scissors
- markers
- 4 safety pins

For knitting an adult size sweater, (optional) you will need circular needle 4 mm and 4,5 mm /US 6 and 7 and/or circular needle 6 and 7 mm / US 10 and 10.75 depending on the yarn used (Léttlopi, Álafoss lopi or a mixed of Love Story and plötulopi) and your gauge.

Any extra knitting equipment such as sets of needles in different sizes to match the gauges, tape measure, etc...
